




Spring Leadership Camp 2006
Camp Meadow Wood Springs at Tollgate
Mar 10-12, 2006

 **What:** The Winter Leadership Camp is a life coping skills camp with an emphasis on building trusting, lasting relationships with peers and teachers. Students go through a series of carefully planned activities that challenge them both physically and emotionally, including a challenge course. The camp is designed by the Leadership/ASB Class at WA-Hi High School. There will be approximately 100 students attending.


 **Where:** The camp is held at Camp Meadow Wood Springs at Tollgate, approximately 35 miles south of Walla Walla. Students are housed in cabins, with separate cabins for boys and girls and all meals are provided by the camp. Students are chaperoned by 10-15 staff members while at camp.

 **When:** Spring Leadership Camp will be Mar. 10-12, 2006. We will be leaving WA-Hi at 8am Friday, Mar. 10 and will return by 3 pm on Sunday, Mar.12. We will be riding in school busses.

 **Bring:** Students will need to bring the following:


- Warm clothes for outside activities
- Sleeping bag & pillow
- Winter jacket, hat & gloves. included an extra pair of gloves
- Pajamas
- Towel/toiletries
- Exercise clothes
- Snacks

Students *SHOULD NOT* bring walkmans, CD players, cell phones, etc. We will not be held responsible for any valuables you choose to bring.

 **Cost:** The cost per student for camp is \$40. This must be paid at time of registration to guarantee a spot at camp. Students failing to attend will lose their deposit.

 **Rules:** Students are expected to follow WA-Hi school rules while at camp. In addition students must:

- Attend and participate in all of the scheduled activities
- Ride the provided bus both to and from the camp
- Abide by "lights out" times
- Leave lodge and cabins in the same condition as when they arrived (students are responsible for any damage)
- Refrain from use of drugs, alcohol, or tobacco
- Stay away from the water front at all times
